



MAKING A 999 CALL

You can use the activities you have already completed to help you with this one.

Using a pretend phone or real phone (with permission), PRETEND to make a 999 call. A sibling or parent/carer can be the call handler and then you can swap. You will need to say which service you need and then explain what happened. You will then need to follow the instructions.

See if you can make calls which use the different emergency services.

Try to learn your address and phone number!

Discussion points:

- Tell child it's preferable to use a land line phone if you have one as it's easier to locate you.
 - Please reinforce how important it is to only make a 999 call in a true emergency. Explain why.
- There are videos online if you search which model making a call for children or you can watch a Daisy First Aid one on social media today.
 - There is a really good app called what3words which gives you 3 unique words for your location to share with the emergency services so you can check this out together.
- If you have pets, discuss making sure they are put away if possible and how the emergency services can access your home.
